From East Salem: Take Lancaster Drive south (name changes to Aumsville Hwy). Continue southeast on Aumsville Hwy to Deer Park Drive SE; turn right and follow signs.

History:	Founded in 1935 in Phoenix, Ariz.; relocated in 1946 to the San Francisco Bay area; to its present location, Salem Ore., in 1969.
Total Enrollment:	2,068

Accreditation:	Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities. Education program approved by Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (State of Oregon) and the Association of Christian Schools International. Graduate counseling program accredited by CACREP.

The library houses the Prewitt-Allen Archaeological Museum, a collection of Middle East artifacts, unique on the West Coast. Both the Corban Library and the Prewitt-Allen Archaeological Museum are open to the public.
