1. Please type a formatted list (see sample chart) of all activities you have been involved in over the last four years. With each activity, list the dates of participation, the number of hours invested and your specific responsibilities or accomplishments.
2. Answer the following questions in a separate typed essay:
 - What qualities make a good leader and why?
 - When and in what way did you demonstrate strong leadership qualities? Give three examples.
 - How will your leadership abilities benefit the Corban community?
3. Submit two letters of recommendation from people who can attest to your leadership abilities.
4. Attach your activities chart, essay and letters of recommendation together, along with the Scholarship Cover Sheet. Be sure to include your name, the date and your GPA (minimum of 3.2 is required to apply).
