Course Credits: 3

Course Duration: 8 weeks

Course Description:

This course provides a biblical, historical, and cultural examination of God's mission to redeem and restore humanity to Him. It presents contemporary mission strategies and provides training in personal outreach and evangelism. It will challenge students to discover God's redemptive purpose in the world to invest their lives in spreading the gospel, make Christ-like disciples, and inspire the worship of God by all peoples.
