Director of Choirs and Professor of Music Education

Position Description

- Position Begins: July 1, 2014
- Salary and Rank: Commensurate with qualifications and experience.
Full-time, regular faculty position.
- Responsibilities: Primary responsibilities will be Director of Choirs, teaching music education courses, overseeing the vocal instruction and advising music education students. Teaching additional music courses will be added based on the candidate's qualifications and department needs. Other duties include academic advising, curriculum and program development, and university and departmental committee work.

Qualifications

- Education: Doctorate preferred with advanced study in Choral Conducting and Choral Music Education. Candidates must also show a minimum 5 years of experience as a certified music teacher at the primary/secondary school levels.
- Experience: Significant conducting and undergraduate teaching experience is strongly preferred. Candidate should have strong teaching skills and have a demonstrated record of active participation in professional organizations. Candidate must qualify for an Oregon State teaching license.
- Character: Faculty candidates must have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and evidence a mature Christian faith. Candidate must also have an exemplary marriage and family life. Candidate must agree by conviction with the University's statement of faith, be committed to the integration of biblical principles in their teaching and be willing to invest themselves in the development of their students. Candidate should also evidence good relationship skills necessary to function effectively on the music department team.
