How To Verify Income Reported On The FAFSA

Why you are asked to complete this process: You reported on the FAFSA that you filed an income tax return (or will file a tax return) for 2014. The government is requiring Corban to verify this information in order to complete your application for financial aid.

There are two options for verifying your income:

We have listed instructions below for using the <u>IRS Data Retrieval Tool</u> through the FAFSA, or ordering an <u>IRS Tax Return</u> Transcript. Either option will work to verify your income, so feel free to use the option that works best for you. Keep in mind, you will not be able to use either option until you have filed a 2014 IRS income tax return.

IRS— Data Retrieval Tool

The IRS Data Retrieval Tool is a tool within the FAFSA used to transfer your 2014 IRS income tax information directly into the FAFSA. This is a secure, safe and reliable way for us to verify your income. If you have filed an IRS income tax return for 2014, go to https://fafsa.gov/ and log in to make corrections. • IRS Tax Return Transcript

The IRS Tax Return Transcript can be ordered online, or by phone and will be mailed to the address on the 2014 IRS income tax return.

BY PHONE: To get a copy by phone call 800-908-9946

Make sure to request a copy of the "TAX RETURN TRANSCRIPT" and NOT the "Tax ACCOUNT Transcript."
