We are looking for an individual who:

- Has a personal relationship with Jesus Christ
- Has a desire to work with people of other cultures
- Displays emotional and spiritual maturity
- Has a 2.0 or higher gpa at time of application
- Has less than 13 reprimands for any given semester

NOTE: True North Corps recognizes that past behavior may not always reflect the current state of the heart and is willing to consider those who may not meet all of the above requirements. If you do not meet one or more of the items listed above, yet you feel that your application should be considered for involvement in one of True North's S.O.S.s please explain on a separate sheet of paper and submit along with your completed application.

The S.O.S. teams will be announced on _____. You will receive an email stating that you have been selected and your deposit will be due by _____. After the S.O.S. teams are announced, you will receive a detailed packet with all of the specific information for your trip. This will include passport information, immunization information; financial giving sheets that you will use as you raise a prayer and financial support team, as well as sample support letters and any other forms that will be required for your trip. We strongly urge you to begin to pray for your S.O.S. and for those that will support you financially. Also please begin to gather names and addresses of those that you can contact for prayer and support. You will need to begin immediately since many of you have a lot of financial responsibility for your .

Finally, you will be contacted by your S.O.S. team leader to meet and get to know one another. Team building is essential for a short term mission trip. He/she will set up training times and be able to provide you with further information regarding your specific trip.

MEETING ATTENDANCE POLICY:

Corban University School of Ministry and True North Corps requires that ALL S.O.S. participants be present at every scheduled S.O.S. meeting and training activities (including pre-S.O.S. retreats). This is done to ensure that each participant receives vital information and training pertaining to the trip. Your meeting times and locations will be made known to you by the True North Corps office.

If you are unable to attend a meeting because of conflict of schedule due to school or work, you are responsible to bring a note to the True North Corps office signed by the professor or employer.

Realize that the opportunity of taking part of the S.O.S. that you are applying for will require a sacrifice in your schedule. This is expected to ensure that you are making every effort possible to attend team meetings and training. Excessive absences with or without excuse notes will be taken into consideration by the True North Corps office as a determining factor to whether or not you will be able to participate in the S.O.S. applied for.

I realize that the following elements are crucial to the effectiveness, quality and safety of our S.O.S. together. As a member of the S.O.S. team, I agree to:

1. Remember that I am a guest working at the invitation of a local missionary or pastor.
2. Remember that I have come to learn, not to teach. I may run across procedures that I feel are inefficient, or attitudes that I find closed minded. I'll resist the temptation to inform our hosts about "how I do things." I'll be open to learning other people's methods and ideas.
3. Respect the host's view of Christianity. I recognize that Christianity has many faces throughout the world, and that the purpose of this trip is to witness and experience faith lived out in a new setting.
4. Develop and maintain a servant's attitude toward all nationals and my teammates.
5. Respect my team leader(s) and his/her decisions.
6. Refrain from gossip. I may be surprised at how each person will blossom when freed from the concern that others may be passing judgment.
7. Refrain from complaining. I know that travel can present numerous unexpected and undesired circumstances, but the rewards of conquering such circumstances are innumerable. I'll try to be creative and supportive.
8. Respect the work that is going on in the country with the particular church, agency, or person(s) that we are working with. I realize that our team is here for just a short while, but that the missionaries and local churches are here for the long term. I will respect their knowledge, insight and instructions.
9. Refrain from negative political comments or hostile discussions concerning our host country's politics.
10. Remember not to be exclusive in my relationships. If my sweetheart or spouse is on the team, we will make every effort to interact with all members of the team, not just one another.
11. Refrain from any activity that could be construed as romantic interest toward a national. realize certain activities that seem innocuous in my own culture may seem inappropriate in others.
12. Abstain from the consumption of alcoholic beverages or the use of tobacco/illegal drugs while on the trip, this policy works in conjunction with adherence to Corban University policy.
13. Due to varied viewpoints on some Christian doctrines (ex: eschatology, spiritual gifts, security of the believer, speaking in tongues, etc.), I agree to refrain from promoting, practicing in private or public, any doctrine, teaching, or gift that is contrary to the beliefs, standards and practices of Corban University.
