Qualifications

Education: Doctorate in the field of ministry from a regionally-accredited or Association of

Theological Schools institution is preferred. The successful candidate without a

doctorate will be expected to complete a doctoral program.

Experience: Significant experience in a field related to women's ministry is required. College

teaching experience is preferred. Candidate should have demonstrated teaching ability, leadership skills, and technology aptitude. Online teaching, publication

and overseas ministry experience are plusses.

Character: Faculty candidates must have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and

evidence a mature Christian faith. Candidate must also have an exemplary marriage and family life. Candidate must agree by conviction with the University's statement of faith, be committed to the integration of biblical principles in their teaching and be willing to invest themselves in the

development of their students. Candidate should also evidence good relationship

skills necessary to function effectively on the School of Ministry team.
