Responsibilities: Primary responsibility is teaching undergraduate exercise science courses and serve as a research mentor for majors. Other duties include academic advising, curriculum and program development, and university and departmental committee work. Corban University faculty are expected to be active scholars, excellent teachers, active in service to the university and the community, and able to model the integration of faith and learning.

**Qualifications**

Education: Doctorate in exercise science, kinesiology or related field preferred. The successful candidate without a doctorate will be expected to complete a doctoral program.

Experience: Significant experience in a field related to exercise science is required and college teaching experience is preferred. Candidate should have strong teaching and leadership skills and have a demonstrated record of active participation in professional organizations.

Character: The candidate must have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and evidence a mature Christian faith, be in agreement with the University's statement of faith, be committed to the integration of biblical principles within the practice of exercise science and be willing to invest him/herself in the development of undergraduate science students. As a program, the exercise science program places great value in collaboration and is therefore desire candidates who have the same teamwork and collaborative values.
