#### **Taking Flight**

The Portland International Airport is located 60 miles north of Salem. The HUT Airport Shuttle offers scheduled transportation between Portland International Airport and the Red Lion Hotel in Salem (located on Market Street). #### From Lancaster Drive

Go south on Lancaster Drive/Aumsville Highway. and continue east to Deer Park Drive (on hill). Turn right at the Corban sign and go south 1/4 mile to the University entrance on left.

#### From Interstate 5

Take Exit 252 (Kuebler Boulevard). Turn east and follow signs. Continue on Kuebler Blvd 3/4 mile and turn right on Turner Road. Proceed 1/2 mile southeast and turn left onto Deer Park Drive (directional sign says Corban Univ). Continue one mile northeast to University main entrance on right.
