MISSION: To educate Christians who will make a difference in the world for Jesus Christ.

RESPONSIBLITIES: Corban University invites applications for a part-time Assistant Debate Coach beginning August 2019 to support the planned growth of the Corban University British Parliamentary Debate Program. This position reports to the Debate Director and primary responsibilities will include teaching and tournament coaching. Candidate will serve as an adjunct instructor, teaching the one-credit CO211 Inter-Collegiate Debate course fall and spring semesters, which also serves as the weekly team practice.

The successful candidate will teach the subject matter in a manner that is consistent with the university's Statement of Faith. Candidate will travel with students to approximately eight tournaments per year, which will require van rental, driving, and a valid driver's license. Other duties include supporting the Director's recruitment, debate scholarship, mentoring, and curriculum and program development efforts.

QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS:

Education: Bachelor's degree required.

Experience: Competitive inter-collegiate debate. No previous debate coaching experience is necessary, but candidate must be willing to learn the British Parliamentary (BP) style of debate.

Character: The candidate must have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and evidence a mature Christian faith, be in agreement with the University's statement of faith, and be committed to the integration of biblical principles within the practice of debate. Candidates should value an environment that reflects the diversity of God's kingdom, engages in global concerns and connects culturally.
