Sticky tack, nails, tacks, or other brands of adhesives are NOT allowed, as they cause damage to the walls. A whiteboard is provided for you outside your door.

**Kitchens:** At least one fully functional kitchen (full fridge, stove/oven, microwave, and a number of utensils) is in each dorm. These are for student use! Expectations on this space will be communicated during the first week.

**Bathrooms:** In Balyo, Davidson and PVG, on each floor, there is a community style bathroom. Aagard rooms include an individual bathroom. Shower curtains are not provided. Toilet paper provided all year.

**Laundry:** We provide free washer and dryer usage for our students. You must provide your own detergent, softener, etc.

**Storage:** For large items, we offer locked storage space to students for no charge during the school year.
