EACH ROOM HAS...

"Bunk-able" regular twin sized mattresses and beds, dressers, desks, and wardrobes. (Aagard residents have a walk-in closet instead.)

RECOMMENDED TO BRING:

- Bedding
- Towels
- Toiletries
- Laundry Supplies
- Tablet/Laptop
- Room Décor
- Clothes Hangers

OPTIONAL TO BRING:

- Small Bookshelf
- Desk Lamp
- Mini-fridges and microwaves.
- Coffee pots must have automatic shut off.

NOT OKAY TO BRING:

- Hot pots, toasters, candle-warmers, and halogen lights.
- Pets (fish in fish tanks of two gallons or less are permissible)
- Firearms, fireworks, illegal or explicit material

You should contact your roommate(s) to coordinate what large items you do or do not need to bring.

Wall Décor: We want Corban to feel like home away from home! With this, we love seeing students using wall space. However, we ask that you only use 3MM command strips to hang your belongings. Sticky tack, nails, tacks, or other brands of adhesives are NOT allowed, as they cause damage to the walls. A whiteboard is provided for you outside your door.

Kitchens: At least one fully functional kitchen (full fridge, stove/oven, microwave, and a number of utensils) is in each dorm. These are for student use! Expectations on this space will be communicated during the first week.

Bathrooms: In Balyo, Davidson and PVG, on each floor, there is a community style bathroom. Aagard rooms include an individual bathroom. Shower curtains are not provided. Toilet paper provided all year.

Laundry: We provide free washer and dryer usage for our students. You must provide your own detergent, softener, etc.

Storage: For large items, we offer locked storage space to students for no charge during the school year.
