

Housing Options

2025-2026



Each of Corban's housing options are unique, but all offer spacious rooms, free laundry facilities, and a welcoming community. Learn more about each residence hall at www.corban.edu/residence-life.

For the 2025-2026 school year, you can request your preferred housing from the following options.

RESIDENCE HALLS	COST PER SEMESTER
Balyo or Davidson – <i>Co-ed dorm with gender-specific halls</i> Double occupancy in a standard room or triple occupancy in a larger room	\$3,776
Prewitt / Van Gilder – <i>Co-ed dorm with gender-specific halls</i> Double, triple, or two-room quad	\$3,445
Aagard – <i>Co-ed dorm with gender-specific halls</i> Two- or four-person suite options	\$3,445
Farrar – <i>All-male dorm</i> Double occupancy in a standard room	\$3,000

If capacity allows, students may apply for an individual room at an increased cost.

2-person bedroom	\$3,445
Single bedroom	\$4,593

TOWNHOUSE LEASES <i>(For Off-Campus Eligible Students)</i>	COST PER MONTH
<i>Leases available for married, graduate, and off-campus eligible students</i>	
2 bed / 2 bath – <i>With in-unit laundry and central AC</i>	\$800
2 bed / 1 bath	\$750

Lease price is per bedroom, and each bedroom is single occupancy, with the exception of married students and their dependents (with a max capacity of 4).

Meal Plans

2025-2026



Meal plans are based on the number of times a student can access the dining hall. For example, “Weekly 19” indicates that students can dine during all 19 scheduled meal times each week. “Weekly 15” indicates that students can choose 15 out of 19 scheduled meal times each week. Block plans allow a student to access a specific number of meals at any time during the semester.

All meal plans also include Warrior Dollars, which may be used at Corban’s Common Grounds coffee shop in the Pavilion.

All on-campus residents are **required** to select a meal plan each semester. This includes townhouse residents, with the exception off-campus eligible residents on a townhouse lease agreement.

- On-campus residents with 60 credits or less must select one of the weekly plans.
- Residential students who have earned more than 60 credits must select a weekly plan or the Block 200 plan.
- Commuter students have the **option** to purchase any block plan.

BLOCK PLANS	COST PER SEMESTER
Block 200 Includes 200 meals & \$200 Warrior Dollars	\$2,466
Block 100 Includes 100 meals & \$100 Warrior Dollars	\$1,175

Students select their meal plans when applying for housing.

Returning students will make their meal plan selections for the full academic year (fall and spring semesters) when signing up for housing for the following year. **No meal plan changes may occur after May 2, 2025.**

New students beginning in the Fall 2025 semester will select a meal plan during the initial housing application process and **may change meal plans until August 1, 2025.**

New students beginning in the Spring 2026 semester will select a meal plan when applying for housing and **may change meal plans until December 1, 2025.**

Block plans may be added at any time during the semester, but may not be removed after the dates listed above, and no refunds will be given.
